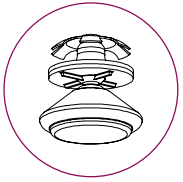
Floor-Saver (5)

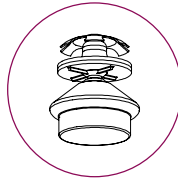

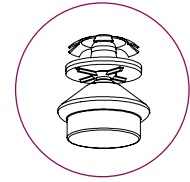

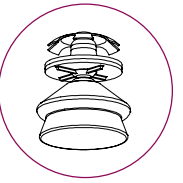

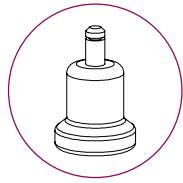

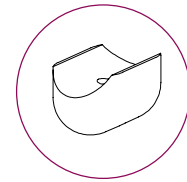
Cantilever Toe Glide
